ZIP LINE TRAINING LEVELS

All Trainings will occur on, and all Certifications are valid for, Global Expeditions, Inc. Zip Line Systems.

Level 1 – Guide Training

Guides will attend each day of a consecutive Guide training session. Guides will demonstrate a basic understanding of the knowledge an entry-level guide must possess, while demonstrating their awareness for safety and guest concern. This will include, but not be limited to: personal safety gear, zip line components, guiding, and an overall understanding of the necessary inspections. Introductions to rescues, evacuations, and on-site first aid procedures will be covered. Minimum of 5 days (8 hours a day) for up to 8 attendees. Certification valid for 1 year.

Level 2 – Lead Guide Training

Lead Guides will attend each day of a consecutive Lead Guide training session. Lead Guides will demonstrate a more complete understanding of the zip line process than a Guide. Abilities to judge a Guide's strengths and weaknesses are necessary to correctly assign Guides to daily roles. Must be able to identify and coordinate any rescue and/or emergency situation that may arise. Demonstrate the ability to give positive and negative feedback to fellow Guides. Can efficiently and effectively run all guiding positions. Full coverage of rescues and evacuations will be covered. Minimum of 3 days (8 hours a day) for up to 4 attendees. Must have a minimum of 400 hours of documented operations experience prior to enrollment. Certification Valid for 2 years.

Level 3 – Trainer

Trainers will attend each day of a consecutive Trainer training session. Trainers will demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of the zip line process. Shows efficient use of all equipment. Effectively train to multiple personalities and learning types. Demonstrate the ability to give positive and negative feedback to Guides. Runs a seamless operation as a Lead Guide. Trainers will have the ability to run Level 1 and Level 2 Trainings on Global Expeditions, Inc. Zip Line Systems. Minimum of 5 days (8 hours a day) for up to 4 attendees not including the first 2 shadowed Guide training session before certification. Must have a minimum of 800 hours of documented operations experience prior to enrollment, 300 hours of which must be as a Lead Guide. Certification valid for 3 years.

Level 4 – Lead Trainer

Lead Trainers will attend each day of a consecutive Lead Trainer training session. Lead Trainers will demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of the zip line training process, as well as the zip line process. Able to train Level 3 Trainers independently after the first course, and Level 4 Lead Trainers under supervision for the first 2 courses. Minimum of 3 days (8 hours a day) for up to 2 attendees not including the first 2 shadowed Trainer training sessions before certification. Must have at least 1000 hours of documented operations experience and 160 hours of documented training experience prior to enrollment. Certification valid for 3 years.
